## 4. Transport, Materials and Resources

Conformar will try to minimize environmental impact with regard to transport, sourcing materials and resources.

Practical implementations are:

- ✓ Reducing the impact on the environment where ever possible with respect to transport, by avoiding unnecessary travel, and using energy efficient vehicles and driving styles.
- ✓ Avoid using materials which have an undesirable effect on the environment, and wherever possible use locally made goods.
- ✓ Use contractors who also share a commitment to the environment, and take into account lifetime costs of materials when repairing, altering or rebuilding premises.
- ✓ Maximize use of electronic communication and information storage as an alternative to paper.
